The 3rd Train—M-10002, *City of Los Angeles*—was placed in service May 15, 1936. Operated jointly by Union Pacific and Chicago & Northwestern between Chicago and Los Angeles, the streamlined train was Pullman-built, including two power units, and 9-car fully-articulated train. In June 1939, the M-10002 was reassigned to the *City of Portland* run. The Coach Yard will offer the 9-car M-10002 with two power units in HO scale, FACTORY pro-finished: lettered and painted with interiors as per prototype.
