Delivered to the Topeka Shops as car “shells” from Pullman, these semi-lightweight Baggage & Express cars first appeared on the Santa Fe in 1956. The first two groups, cars 3700-3749 and 3750-3799, went into service in 1956 and 1958, respectively. Over the next six years 140 more cars of the same type were accepted into service: 3800-3939. The Coach Yard will offer seven different versions in HO scale FACTORY pro-finished: lettered and painted per prototype. Cars will be available in grey with black roof and silver trucks, silver, silver assigned to Business Car fleet, and as modified as steam generator cars.
